PRODUCT NAME: DAZZLE GLOW FLUORESCENT EMULSION PAINT

General Surface Preparation & Directions for Use:

Kaleidoscope Dazzle Glow Flourescent Emulsion Paint is supplied ready to apply brush, roller or spray. **Stir well before use.** Apply two coats allowing at least 2-4 hours between coats.

NEW SURFACES: Ensure that surfaces are thoroughly dry and free from all dust, dirt, grease and grime. Apply two coats of Kaleidoscope Dazzle Glow Flourescent Emulsion Paint, allowing at least 2-4 hours between coats.

PREVIOUSLY PAINTED SURFACES: Remove all wax and polish, grease and grime. Remove any flaking previous coating to get a sound substrate. Apply one or two coats as necessary.

CAUTION: Use only with adequate ventilation. If you experience eye watering, headaches, or dizziness, increase fresh air or wear an approved particulate respirator (Follow respirator manufacturer's direction for respirator use) or leave the area. Avoid contact with eyes. Wash hands after using. Keep container closed when not in use. Do not transfer contents to other containers for storage.

FIRST AID: In case of eye contact, flush thoroughly with large amounts of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, get medical attention immediately.
